2018 was a year of blessings, challenges and visions of what lies ahead for Impact Ministries. The US division had a major change as our long time Directors stepped away to serve in other ways. New Operations Managers and Team Coordinator have stepped into these roles.

A new member data base, NEON, was launched that manages accounts including donations, sponsorship tracking and communications with each member.

Results of yours prayers, your giving and your going:

- A little over 300K was donated in 2018
- Since 2011 \$1.3 million has been sent to help the students and families in Guatemala.
- And most importantly - the Lord continues to work through Impact Ministries in Guatemala! The harvest is ripe and lives are being changed for eternity!

Education Programs

Educational Programs

Vida Schools, 7 campuses operating 10 separate schools, provided education, spiritual instruction and a meal a day to over 1500 students.

Support a Class and Child Sponsorship Programs

These programs provide funding needed for the godly education of the children. This includes the operating costs of the schools, classroom resources, daily meals for the children, teacher's wages etc.

There were 60 Support a Class sponsors who provide a total of 112 units of support.

90 children were sponsored through the Child Sponsorship program.

Short-term Teams and Field Workers

Short Term Teams

In 2018 Impact Ministries hosted 8 short team teams

- ◆ 4 medical teams who provided general medical, dental and chiropractic care.
- ◆ 4 church teams who partnered with the Junior and Senior high students from Vida Schools to provide children's ministry programming. The teams also assisted with construction projects, primarily working on the Chamche school construction site.

Field Worker

One field worker spent six weeks with the ministry providing much needed translation assistance to the teams that came from the United States and Canada.

Support Programs

Rio de Vida Church

The three congregations continued to flourish with new leaders stepping up and contributing to a vibrant and committed church. The new church building continues to progress with all the congregations joining together frequently for a joint service. The church construction costs have been completely covered by the local believers.

Medical/Dental Clinic Program

The two Guatemalan clinic staff coordinated North American medical team schedules. They provided assistance to the teams and followed up care with patients. They ensured supplies were stocked and that students and staff were assessed prior to the arrival of each team. Sometimes they even set up clinics in remote locations.

Apart from their work with teams the clinic staff also treated injuries and common illnesses, provided healthy living instruction and so much more.

Children's Home

The home was completed and approval was received from the government. The first child arrived into our care and we anticipate more babies to arrive soon.

Agriculture Program

In striving to create sustainability many of the acres were planted with corn and tomatoes this year. Food was also grown for the school feeding program.
