How do short-term mission teams make a long-term impact?

By participating in furthering the impact of almost 20 years of community involvement in Guatemala! Come alongside Impact Ministries as we train Guatemalans for leadership by developing Christian schools, providing local outreach programs, developing orphan care and planting churches.

Many people have already experienced the life-changing effects of our short-term mission teams. Who knows, the life you impact just might be your own!

What will my short-term mission team do?

In addition to a variety of cultural activities designed to further your understanding of God's work in Guatemala, you will also work alongside the staff of Impact Ministries and participate in a variety of community outreach projects, such as:

- children's ministry
- construction projects
- evangelism outreach
- home visits
- devotionals and prayer ministry

Medical teams serve in our clinic or provide much-needed health care in remote mountain villages, while other professionals may have opportunity to serve the community with their skills.

When can I go?

Short-term mission trips take place from January to October each year, and are generally 11 days long. Specialty teams may serve for different lengths of time. Discuss your options with our Teams Coordinator.

How can I go?

You can form your own team, or join one of the Impact Ministries-organized teams.

Most of our teams are organized by schools, churches or special interest groups who want to serve together through Impact Ministries in Guatemala.

Impact Ministries also hosts a sponsor/family team and a seniors team.

Impact Ministries has been hosting short-term mission teams from schools, churches, and communities across North America since 2000, and looks forward to working with your team.

Why Guatemala?

Years of hardship have prepared the hearts of the Guatemalan people, and they are hungry for the truth of Jesus Christ!

In the rural areas of Guatemala, more than 75% of indigenous people live in poverty, and many children don't complete elementary school. Local religions combine Mayan traditions, Roman Catholicism, and witchcraft, resulting in an oppressive religious spirit that keeps people in fear and bondage. Impact Ministries is focused on bringing help and the hope of Jesus Christ to the Q'eqchi' and Poqomchi' people groups of Guatemala.
